Naviance for Middle School is a college and career readiness program that helps students discover strengths and interests and learn about careers that may interest them. It is a helpful tool that enables students to begin to think about their future goals and aspirations. Part of the journey to career readiness is identifying interests and connecting those interests to future careers, coursework and graduation pathways.





Honors Classes

Honors classes begin in Grade 7 and are offered in the following subjects:

- English, mathematics, science and social studies
- Accelerated study beyond grade level
- Mastery expected on subject-area assessment
- Road to HS Honors and Advanced Placement courses

Placement in honors classes is dependent on meeting the following criteria:

- Average of 90 or above in subject
- At least two (2) RIT scores above grade level on MAP test
 - Reading MAP used for English and social studies
 - Mathematics MAP used for mathematics and science
- Recommendation of current subject area teacher
